We're grateful and we're thankful right now to place on the Holy Altar Fire of Divine Love, all belief in lack, all belief in limitation, placing on the altar all belief in unworthiness, all jealousy, all thoughts of revenge. We're surrendering all these beliefs that no longer serve our walk of Love. We are willing to shine the Light and be the Light and radiate the Light of Love that we are now and forever.

We're sharing the benefits of our healing and our expansion with everyone because we're One with them. So grateful and so thankful to allow our healing to be, we let it be, and so it is. Amen. Amen.

We are God's Treasure

Yes. We're putting an end to worthiness this week. It's about time. Yes. *A Course of Miracles* is going to help us.

Chapter 8, The Journey Back, Section VI, The Treasure of God.

"We are the joint will of the Sonship, whose wholeness is for all. We begin the journey back by setting out together, and gather in our brothers as we continue together."

That's really the purpose of this radio show. That's the purpose of everything that I offer is for us to join together on this journey back.

"Every gain in our strength is offered for all, so they, too, can lay aside their weakness and lack of strength to us."

That's why you'll always hear my prayer, "We're going to share the benefits with everyone because we're One with them. All boats rise on this tide of Love."

It says, "God's welcome waits for us all, and He will welcome us as I am welcoming you. Forget not the Kingdom of God for anything the world has to offer."

Let's not trade the Kingdom of God for anything the world has to offer. Seek first the Kingdom, which is within, and all else be added unto you. So, knowing that, why would we trade it for the Kingdom? Why would we trade a single thing in the world for the entirety of the Kingdom? That would be insanity! So, the end of insanity is the end of unworthiness.

"The world can add nothing to the power and the glory of God and His holy sons."

Nothing can be added to our stature, nothing can be added to our power and glory. Okay, let's allow that to resonate in our mind.

"The world can add nothing to the power and the glory of God and His holy sons, but the world can blind the sons to the Father if they behold it."

So, if we make the world real and value it above God, then we are saying bye-bye to the Kingdom temporarily.

"You cannot behold the world..." Beholding the world is really to value the world and to treasure the world versus the Kingdom which is within.

"You cannot behold the world and know God."

So, one or the other. That's what I love so much about *A Course in Miracles* is it's so clear. You cannot behold the world and know God.

"Only one is true." Only one is true. So, the Kingdom of God is true and the Kingdom of God is within.

"I am come to tell you that the choice of which is true is not yours to make.

We don't get to decide whether or not the Kingdom within is true or the world is true. That decision—there is no decision. The Kingdom is true and the world is false. The world is a projection.

"If it were possible for us to decide what was true, we would've destroyed ourselves. Yet God did not will the destruction of His creations, having created them for eternity."

We cannot be destroyed. We cannot be destroyed. For those who fear death, fear destruction, fear that the body's death and dying experiences could somehow destroy us, it cannot. We are created for eternity.

"God's Will has saved you, not from yourself, but from your illusion of yourself."

When we identify with the illusion of the personality and the body, then we think we are born to die. However, our true self can never be damaged, hurt, endangered, destroyed, or in any way sullied. This is what I was talking about last week is that we are beings of Light, and Light cannot be sullied or dirtied. You can filter it and you can block it, but can in no way make it dirty or bad or wrong or sullied.

"Let us glorify..." Oops, I skipped the part.

"God's will has saved you, not from yourself, but from your illusion of yourself."

He has saved you for yourself. I love that. The protective Father has saved us for ourselves, for all eternity.

"Let us glorify God whom the world denies, for over God's Kingdom the world has no power. No one created by God can find Joy in anything except the eternal."

So, Joy only can be discovered, felt, and experienced in our understanding of the eternal.

"Not because God has deprived us of any—not because we're deprived of anything else, because nothing else is worthy of us."

All are worthy of the Kingdom. That's why the Kingdom is preinstalled in each and every one of us.

"What God and His Sons create is eternal, and in this and this only is our Joy.

Listen to the story of the prodigal son, and learn what God's treasure is and yours: This son of a loving father left his home and thought he had squandered everything for nothing of any value..."

He thought he had squandered everything in exchange for nothing of any value.

"...although he had not understood its worthlessness at the time. He was ashamed to return to his father, because he thought he had hurt him. Yet when he came home, the father welcomed him with Joy, because the son himself was the father's treasure. The father wanted nothing else.

God wants only His son because His son is His only treasure."

The Sonship of which we are apart is the Christ and that is the only begotten Son, the Child. We are that. We are the treasure of God and we are God's only treasure. This is what Jesus is telling us.

"You want your creations as God wants His. Your creations are the gift to the Holy Trinity, created in gratitude for your creation. They do not leave you any more than you left your Creator, but they extend your creation as God extended Himself to you."

Okay. So, what does that mean? Our creations are our expressions of Love. All expressions of Love are maximal. Our expressions of Love, our expression of truths, our expressions of Beauty are maximal, because Love

is not little or more Love or less Love. We can't actually fall into Love and out of Love. That's insanity. Love is the ground of our being.

When we're expressing Love, and Beauty, and truth, and Creativity, and Wisdom, and Clarity, and Purity, and all of the spiritual qualities of God, these are our creations. And just as these our creations, we are the creation of God. We are Beauty, and truth, and Wisdom, and Clarity, and Freedom, and Wholeness, and all of these spiritual qualities, that's what we are. So, we in turn can express them.

That's why if we seek the Kingdom first, all else is added unto us. Because if we seek the Kingdom, which is within, which is ours eternally, when we seek to know that this treasure that we are is our true identity, that these spiritual qualities: Love, Wholeness, Peace, Harmony, Freedom, Prosperity, Creativity, Beauty, truth, all of these spiritual qualities are our essential nature. They are the Kingdom that's pre-installed.

When we seek to know them and to reveal them and to express them, all else is added unto us because all else is the remembrance of our eternal nature. So, then we realize what is real and what is false and we no longer value what is false. This is the salvation. This is the Atonement. This is the waking up. This is the ascension. This is the resurrection. Now is the time of our resurrection.

Living in Joy

"Can the creations of God Himself take Joy in what is not real?"

Can we actually experience Joy which is a spiritual quality versus temporary fleeting sense of pleasure or happiness? Can we experience true Joy in what is not real in celebrating the false and identifying with the false, in treasuring that which is temporal and temporary? No, we cannot. This is what the teaching is here.

"And what is real except the creations of God and those that are created like His?"

There's nothing else that's real, except our true eternal nature and our expressions of Love, our God Nature.

"Your creations love you as you love your Father for the gift of creation. There is no other gift that is eternal, and therefore there is no other gift that is true. How, then, can you accept anything else or give anything else, and expect joy in return?"

It's insanity.

"And what else but joy would you want?"

This is one of the things I hear so many Light worker say, "Joy. I would like to experience Joy. I would like to know Joy. I would like to live in Joy." Here is a practice to every day, throughout the day, when you notice you're not experiencing Joy. Turn to the Holy Spirit, turn to Jesus, turn to our elder brother Jesus and the great comforter, the Holy Spirit, and say, "I am willing to know true Joy. I am willing to know true Joy. I am willing to live in Joy. I'm willing to live a joyful life. I am willing to be joyful. Show me how. Teach me. And they will for that is their Joy. What else but Joy would you want?

Feeling of Unworthiness

"You made neither yourself nor your function."

So, our function is forgiveness and to seek only the Kingdom, to choose to wake up, to choose the Atonement for ourselves.

"You made only the decision to be unworthy of both."

Unworthy of Joy and unworthy of forgiveness.

"Yet you cannot make yourself unworthy because you are the treasure of God, and what He values is valuable. There can be no question of its worth, because its value lies in God's sharing Himself with it and establishing its value forever."

We're expressions of God. We're creations of God. Therefore, our value, our worthiness is forever established. We cannot make ourselves unworthy. Anyone who feels unworthy, anyone who feels bad, anyone who feels wrong, anyone who feels lacking, anyone who feels that they are limited, for any reason whatsoever, is valuing the false, valuing the opinions and the judgments and the meaning that you made of things.

This is why Jesus starts the Workbook with looking around the room and realizing that everything I see only has the meaning that I've given it. If I feel upset, it's not for the reason I think, it's not because of anything that's happening in the world, it's because I have forsaken the Kingdom in my mind. I have forgotten who I am. I have decided I am unworthy. If you believe that anyone is unworthy of Compassion, Love, or forgiveness, you cannot feel worthy because the thoughts that you project out in the world

are the things that you believe about yourself, because you are one with everyone that you meet, and everyone that you see with the body size, every part of the Kingdom you're one with, which means you're one with the Treasure of God. You're one with the Peace of God. You're one with the Wholeness of God. You're one with the Freedom of God. You're one with the Love of God eternally.

This is the complete and total end of unworthiness. You made only the decision to be unworthy of Joy, unworthy of forgiveness, and you can choose again. That's the Beauty of this teaching. It's so clear. If you don't like what you have, know that what you are experiencing is an out picturing of your beliefs. You don't have to—we talked about change your beliefs. You don't actually have to change your beliefs, just give them to the Holy Spirit for healing.

If you're trying to figure out how to change your beliefs, feels like too heavy a burden, let the Holy Spirit do the heavy lifting. Let's the Holy Comforter and Jesus lead and guide all the way today. Yes.

The Prodigal Son

Let's go back to our topic of unworthiness. What is Section, *The Treasure of God*, in Chapter 8? It's telling us that we are the Treasure of God. The Treasure of God cannot be diminished or harmed in any way. We are eternal. We are eternally the Treasure of God.

One of the main themes in *A Course in Miracles* is that the only reason we feel unworthy is because we have made up a story or many, many stories. We continue to play out those stories, just like the prodigal son played out his story.

We've been given this opportunity to express in this world and through the use of projection and our mind to create an illusory world where we can make in this world basically whatever we'd like using our thoughts and our beliefs. And now, we're on the return home.

You know, how in the prodigal son's story, he—just like the story of Buddha, which others—the beautiful book *Siddhartha*. It's a wonderful, wonderful fictional story written by Hermann Hesse. I highly recommend *Siddhartha*, the book about Buddha's journey.

Like Buddha, the prodigal son went into the world and experienced all the pleasures of carnal life and living and drinking, the pleasures of the body. Including even not just the pleasures, but the degradation of the body. He ends up squandering his financial inheritance. So, he asked his father's first inheritance which is the ability to use the mind and to make choices. He takes that inheritance and he squanders it on loose living, fast living.

Then what happens is he ends up with nothing left and he needs to support himself. He's working on a pig farm and he is taking care of the pigs. As he's giving the pigs their food, he realizes, the pigs eat better than I do. I could go home to my father's house and be a servant there, and I would have a better life than here taking care of the pigs.

You have to remember this, Jesus was a Jew. So, pigs were animals so unclean, that the Jews don't eat them. He was living amongst the pigs and the pigs were eating better than him.

Jesus is using these images in the story to really paint the picture. It helps to understand what that really meant to the Jews of that time. That living amongst the pigs and the pigs are eating better than him.

It's because he has fallen so low. He has become so willing to do something different. He has achieved a place of humility. He no longer has hubris. He no longer thinks that he's better or special. He is having the recognition of true humility. This is what opens his mind to the awareness that he could go home to his father's house and live as a slave in his father's house and have a better life than he can make for himself. So, he travels home.

This is our journey, we're traveling home. We literally are being welcomed back. It takes humility to be able to make that journey home.

Humility: Modest View of One's Own Importance

The invitation here, if you feel any unworthiness, if you feel bad or wrong in any ways you perform, undeserving, guilty, ashamed, if you have any of those feelings and beliefs about yourself, the thing that is going to turn it all, so that you can return home, is that humility.

Some people come to humility by recognizing that no one is better and no one is worse, all are one. If all are one, how could there be better? How could there be worse? You can believe in better or worse and believe in Oneness. You have to choose which system of thinking that you're going to

think with. Are you going to think the thoughts of God which are of Oneness or are you going to think the thoughts of ego which are of separation, better than and less than?

Any time in your day when you recognize, when you consciously become aware that you're thinking this is better and this is worse, they are better and I am worse, I am better and they are worse, any of those thoughts, that's a recognition that you do not believe in the Oneness. You're not interested in the Oneness. You are actively choosing separation and you are actively choosing unworthiness, because our sense of worthiness comes from one thing and one thing only, and it is joining. It is Oneness. It is recognizing the perfection and the Wholeness of our brothers and sisters.

This is why Jesus tells us all throughout *A Course in Miracles* that our brother is our salvation because it's how we see our brothers is how we're going to see ourselves. So, it requires true humility which is valuing the Oneness.

This is a great tool to put an end to unworthiness. You're not going to be in your mind really making that journey home actively until you have humility.

A Journey Back Home to God

Yeah. So, searching your mind for anyone you think is better than or less than you and recognizing it's not possible because you're one with them, there's your ticket on your journey home.

On a daily basis, hourly basis, moment-by-moment basis, you can Partner Up with the Higher Holy Spirit Self with Jesus and say, "Help me to know all are worthy and I am with all, so I am worthy. Help me to see that all my brothers and sisters are worthy of being God's Treasure."

Even Hitler is worthy of being God's treasure because Hitler was, is, however we want to think about it, eternally God's Treasure. He didn't know that about himself, and he didn't know about his brothers and sisters. He came, perhaps, to teach us in the same way, perhaps, that Jesus came to teach us.

Jesus tells us in *A Course in Miracles*, He did not condemn anyone because he knew He couldn't be betrayed. It wasn't even possible. Everything works together for our good. Everything. Every learning experience is truly

helpful. Everything is gently planned by One whose only purpose is our good.

Imagine Jesus standing in the awareness as the crucifixion is looming and He knows it, and knows that even the crucifixion, even a violent death is gently planned by One whose only purpose is His good.

Yes, this is why He was such a teacher, because He had the Christ awakened in His mind already. This is our coming home, coming home to the Christ in our mind.

What happens when the prodigal gets home? The father runs to welcome him. The parents run to welcome him.

The prodigal son was ashamed to return to his father because he thought he had hurt his father. Yet, when he came home, the father welcomed him with Joy because the son himself was his father's treasure. He wanted nothing else.

God wants only his son because his son is his only treasure. Let us remember that we are the Treasure of God. Let us remember that all of our brothers and sisters are the Treasure of God.

Now, I always think that there's an important aspect to the prodigal son's story. He has in his mind he can go home and be a servant in his father's house. Now, to me, that's the same thing as that decision to live our purpose.

Choosing to Serve God

Our purpose—on page 28 in the Text.

"I'm here only to be truly helpful."

When we recognize that, then we're of service. *A Course in Miracles* tells us that being of service is the greatest thing. We can choose to be of service every minute of every day.

In the Principles of Miracles, it talks about service, and this choosing this Atonement for ourselves is the greatest act of service.

In Chapter 1, the *Meaning of Miracle*, Section V, Paragraph 5:

"Whatever is true is eternal and cannot change or be changed."

Jesus has been telling us that we're eternal. We cannot be changed. We cannot be. Our eternal perfection in Christ cannot be diminished. The Light cannot be sullied or dirty.

How could we come to believe so intently that we're unworthy, that we're guilty, that we're to blame, that we're bad, that we're wrong, that we're evil, that any of these thoughts that we come to think about ourselves? They have to be part of the illusion. They can't be part of our true eternal nature.

"Whatever is true is eternal and cannot be change or be changed. Spirit is therefore unalterable because it is already perfect, but the mind can elect what it chooses to serve."

So, each day, whom will you serve, God or mammon? Mammon is the ego. Mammon is humanity in the sense of the ego. Choose Me this day whom you will serve. That is our practice to begin each day, by choosing what we will serve. Are we going to serve Love? Are we going to serve the Holy Spirit? Are we going to serve our brothers and sisters, or are we going to serve the ego?

"The only limit put on our choice is that we cannot serve two masters."

We can only choose one; fear or Love. If we elect to try to choose two masters, it says,

"The mind can become the medium by which Spirit creates. . . "I'm sorry.

"If we elect, the mind can become the medium by which Spirit creates along the line of its own creation."

If we elect to align with the Holy Spirit, to align with our elder brother Jesus, we can create expressions of Love. Yes, we can. We can create along the line of our own creation because we are created in Love as Love. We can create expressions of Love. All expressions of Love are maximal.

"If it does not freely elect to do so, it retains its creative potential, but places itself under tyrannous rather than authoritative control."

We can elect to put our control under the ego or Love. As a result, if we choose the ego—

"As a result, it imprisons, because such are the dictates of the tyrants. To change your mind means to place it at the disposal of true authority."

So, do you feel trapped? Do you feel stuck? Do you feel imprisoned? It's because you've given your ego over to the tyrannical ego. Yes, the tyrannical ego, but you can give it to the Holy Spirit.

This is the living practice of *A Course in Miracles*. *A Course in Miracles* is all about every day, all day long, that practice is to give your mind over to the Holy Spirit, to allow it to be purified and cleansed and cleared. You don't ever have to think about how is it going to happen, how is the miracle going to enfold.

It says here,

"The miracle is a sign that the mind has chosen to be led by me in Christ's service."

We're going back to service again.

"The miracle is a sign that the mind has chosen to be led by me in Christ's service."

What is a miracle? A miracle is when we shift from thinking with the ego to thinking with the Christ.

"The Abundance of Christ is the natural result of choosing to follow him. All shallow roots must be uprooted, because they are not deep enough to sustain you.

"The illusion that shallow roots can be deepened, and thus made to hold, is one of the distortions on which the reverse of the Golden Rule rests."

Okay. So, this is why Jesus told us to build our house on a solid foundation, not on sinking sands. So, here now, He's using the metaphor of deep roots and shallow roots, that if you build your house by the ego's instruction in the shallowness of the world of form, your house won't stand. However, the deep roots of God are going to sustain you through all situations and occurrences.

It says, "The illusion that shallow roots can be deepened, and thus made to hold, is one of the distortions on which the reverse of the Golden Rule rests."

The Golden Rule is, "Do unto others as you would have done unto you." The reverse of that would be to, "Do to others what the ego wishes to be done to them and thinking that you're not one with them." So, let's align and do unto other as we would have done unto ourselves.

You Are Your Own Judge

I'm Jennifer Hadley and we're talking about the *End of Unworthiness* and how to get there or, really, how to be there, how to live in the Kingdom, and to remember that we are the Treasure of God.

Chapter 3, *The Innocent Perception*, Section VI, *Judgment and the Authority Problem*. We were just talking about authority.

In Paragraph 4:

"You are very fearful of everything you have perceived but have refused to accept. You believe that, because you have refused to accept it, you've lost control over it. This is why you see it in nightmares, or in pleasant disguises in what seem to be your happier dreams. Nothing that you have refused to accept can be brought into awareness. It is not dangerous in itself, but you have made it seem dangerous to you."

We've made waking up seemed dangerous.

It says, "When you feel tired, it is because you have judged yourself as capable of being tired. When you laugh at someone, it is because you have judged him as unworthy. When you laugh at yourself you must laugh at others, if only because you cannot tolerate the idea of being more unworthy than they are. All this makes you feel tired because it is essentially disheartening. You're not really capable of being tired, but you are very capable of wearying yourself. The strain of constant judgment is virtually intolerable. It is curious that an ability so debilitating would be so deeply cherished. Yet, if you wish to be the author of

reality, you must insist on holding on to judgment. You will also regard judgment with fear, believing that it will someday be used against you."

Because do unto others as you would've done unto to you, because what you do to others will be done to you. That's the law of karma.

"If you wish to be the author of reality, you will insist on holding on to judgment."

If you're thinking that you can make reality, you're going to hold on to your judgments.

"You will also regard judgment with fear, believing that it will someday be used against you. This belief can exist only to the extent you believe in the efficacy of judgment as a weapon of defense for your own authority."

If you believe your judgments, and if you believe that they are valuable, then you will fear being judged. That's how it is. The judger always feels judged. The attacker always feels attacked, and the lover always feels beloved. You get to choose how you're going to experience your life. You get to choose.

"God offers only mercy. Your words should reflect only mercy, because that is what you have received and that is what you should give. Justice is a temporary expedient or an attempt to teach you the meaning of mercy. It is judgmental only because you are capable of injustice."

It seems in this world of affects, what goes around, comes around to teach us, to teach us and to help us to learn and become the happy learner.

Jesus says, "I have spoken of different symptoms, and at that level there is almost endless variation. There is, however, only one cause for all of them, and that's the authority problem."

If you give your spiritual authority to the ego tyrant, you're going to experience feeling tired, feeling pain, the endless symptoms of suffering. If you give your authority, the authority over your mind to the Holy Spirit, to the Higher Self, to the I AM Presence, then every symptom the ego makes will fall away and your mind will be cleared and purified. This is accepting the Atonement for yourself.

Jesus says, "Every symptom the ego makes involves a contradiction in terms, because the mind is split between the ego and the Holy Spirit, so that whatever the ego makes is incomplete and contradictory. This untenable position is the

result of the authority problem which, because it accepts the one inconceivable thought as its premise, can produce only ideas that are inconceivable."

When we are aligned with the ego, we're going to experience this constant array of symptoms which are symptoms of belief in separation. What is the antidote to all the symptoms of suffering is Oneness, choosing Oneness. It really goes back to that constant choice that we make all day long to judge others or ourselves as unworthy, not good enough, bad, wrong, mistaken.

What could you not accept if you but knew that all event, situations, occurrences are gently planned by One who's only purpose is your good. One whose only purpose is to teach you that you're delusions, illusions, and your judgments have no value? It's learning the same lesson over and over and over again, that the belief in the problem of separation is a false belief. There is no separation, therefore, there is no problem. There is no unworthiness.

Paragraph 8, "The issue of authority is really a question of authorship. When you have an authority problem, it is always because you believe you are the author of yourself and project your delusion onto others."

We are the Treasure of God. The treasure is within. The Kingdom is within. It's in our heart. That's our home. That's our true awareness. We're returning home to our heart. The prodigal son is returning home.

Yes. We get to choose it each and every day, all day long. Choose again, choose again. If you're not feeling ever increasing Joy, happiness, Love, Freedom, Prosperity, Wholeness, Harmony, choose again. Choose again, choose again.

It's about being willing to be aware of all the choices that you make for either the Kingdom or the imprisonment for feeling tired. Sick and tired are symptoms of choosing separation.

Everybody has their own journey. The thing that's really important is not to judge the journey, not to make any meaning of it, whatsoever. I do not know what anything is for. But I'd like to, I'd like to open my mind to that pure awareness that I know what everything is for. It's for my learning, it's for my healing. It's helpful. I'm dedicating my life to a life of service.

The greatest service that we can provide is being truly helpful which really is choosing the Atonement for ourselves, making loving choices. Surrendering the right to judge and attack, anyone or anything. I do not

know what anything is for. This is our pathway of worthiness. Yes. And it's lit. It's well lit by the Holy Spirit and our elder brother Jesus beckoning us all day, every day. Yes.
